The purpose of this post is to warn the users of the Snackbox application for Windows Phone 8 that its security may not be as secure as claimed. The application is available on the Windows Phone Store and is recommended to all users. As it is a game application I shall not name it here. What is worrisome is that the mobile version of the application has been downloading the Snackbox executable file. Since the executable is found on the device, it can be uploaded to other devices remotely via Bluetooth. Once the executable is uploaded, a user on another device can get a binary of the application, which it can load and use without leaving a trace. What is this?
