For a product with more than 30 years of history, AutoCAD has changed dramatically over the years. As AutoCAD was developed, it provided a variety of 3D modeling features that were not available in other commercial CAD programs. These features became the blueprint for later generations of CAD products. Autodesk AutoCAD has also been available for several different platforms. As of 2019, the most recent version of AutoCAD is AutoCAD 2019. History The roots of AutoCAD go back to the early 1980s, before the era of the personal computer. Originally designed as a small-scale set of design applications, Autodesk's original AutoCAD, released in 1982, was designed to be used at the very end of a traditional drafting process. The user would create the drawing at a raster-based screen, and then send it over a phone line to a print shop or other vendor, to be created as a physical print. The first version of AutoCAD cost \$600 and took three hours to download. While this was a time-consuming and costly process, it was ideal for quick access to the latest design changes before the physical work began. Autodesk AutoCAD has been a revolutionary tool for engineers, architects, draftsmen, and designers. It allowed designers to spend their time creating concepts, instead of rastering drawings over a phone line. This paradigm shift in how design was done created a revolution in the world of CAD. As CAD became the norm for almost any work that involved creating diagrams or drawings, the market for AutoCAD continued to grow. In fact, AutoCAD actually became one of the first "post-PC" apps, available on desktops running OS 9 or OS X. This new era of design became the focus of a new version of AutoCAD, AutoCAD LT, which was released in May 1999. In 2013, Autodesk announced a redesign of AutoCAD LT for the iPad, allowing architects and engineers to work directly on iPad drawings. The new version, AutoCAD WS, was launched in June 2014. The first commercial graphical user interface (GUI) for AutoCAD was called Draw. Released in 1988, it was available as part of the 1982 release of AutoCAD. It was an upgrade from the previous version of AutoCAD, named CADD (Computer-Aided Drafting). CADD, originally introduced in the

Mac AutoCAD Product Key AutoCAD was ported to the Macintosh in 1987. Apple Inc. was the company that developed and licensed AutoCAD, first for the Macintosh, then Windows. Macintosh AutoCAD first came out in 1987. The Mac version had no native 64-bit file support. AutoCAD was a 32-bit application and files were limited to a 4 GB hard drive. Thus, a simple file could have a 32-bit size. AutoCAD's installation packages were in at least three formats: MacOS, MacOS Classic, and MacOS Extended. AutoCAD could be run either as a stand-alone application or integrated with MacOS. The Mac version of AutoCAD has had multiple versions. It first came with Mac OS version 8 and was not as feature-rich as its Windows counterpart. Mac AutoCAD versions 9 through 11, introduced in 1993, continued to be feature-limited to small bitmap images. Mac AutoCAD version 12 (1994) could read and write DWG files. In 1995, Mac OS version 10 introduced support for AutoCAD's cross-platform capabilities. Mac OS version 11 and 12 were separate products with separate file formats. The Mac version of AutoCAD 12 was shipped with Mac OS version 10. In 1997, Mac OS version 10.1 introduced a new API for 32-bit applications. The Mac version of AutoCAD 12 was replaced by AutoCAD Classic. AutoCAD Classic was more feature-rich but not as interoperable as Mac AutoCAD. The Mac version of AutoCAD Classic, released in 1998, continued to use the Macintosh's file system. Mac AutoCAD Classic was a 32-bit application. Mac OS version 10.5 (Leopard) introduced a new application programming interface for 32-bit applications. AutoCAD Classic version 15 continued to be 32-bit, and was released in 2004. AutoCAD Classic was a 32-bit application for Mac OS version 10.6 (Snow Leopard). AutoCAD Classic version 16 and 17 (2010 and 2011) are 64-bit applications for Mac OS version 10.7 (Lion) and later. AutoCAD Classic version 18 and later supports 64-bit and file sizes greater than 4 GB
